The end of October see's our fishing competitions come to a close. For some it's a relief that the fishing will slow down, while for others it's an opportunity to fish new areas and start their recon for next year. For me it's a bit of both. It also reminds me that the Mackerel season is just around the corner, closely followed by the Prawns!

We had an Inshore trip on the 7<sup>th</sup> this month. Despite the rain and poor weather predictions we still had 17 competitors weigh in on the Sunday. There was an abundance of good quality whiting with 16 fish tipping the scales over the 400g bonus weight. The bragging rights of catching the heaviest whiting for the year are always highly sought after. That sunday we saw the weight upgrade twice. Eva Mathews caught a stonker 660g whiting only to be dwarfed by Gavin Harvey's 730g horse!

Stuart Bush won first place with 260 Points .Stuart caught 5 bream, 7 whiting, 2 flathead, 2 snapper, 2 mowong and 2 barred trumpeter. He had three bonus fish - 810g Bream, 455g whiting & 1.7kg flathead. Second place went to Scott Nolan with 222 points. Scott caught 2 bream and 10 whiting. Six of his whiting were over 400g! Species of the trip was won by Tommy Martin with a quality 2.140kg Flathead.

Unfortunately I couldn't attend the Somerset Dam trip on the 19<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup> October. Reports from those that did tell me it was pretty hot, with plenty of sunshine and not much breeze during the mornings. The fish and red claw were hard to find, which surprises me as I thought the warmer weather would make them more active? I guess that's fishing! On Saturday night they all enjoyed a Chinese buffet cooked by Danny Salfus.

The offshore crew had two last trips booked in but the weather reared its ugly head.....again. There are suggestion's to plan additional backup dates for next year's calender in an effort to get some more offshore trips in.

The last inshore trip for the year was on the 28<sup>th</sup> Oct. The Saturday was lumpy to say the least but as the sun set the wind died right off. The fish were a bit hard to find but those that put in the effort were well rewarded. Mark Mills won both first place with 256 points and the species of the trip with his 525g whiting. He caught 2 bream, 10 whiting, 1 javelin fish and one tarwhine. Eva Mathews won 2<sup>nd</sup> place with 146 points. Eva caught 10 whiting and two sole fish. Three of her whiting went over bonus weight.

I'd like to thank Mick & Gina Kolodko and all the volunteers that helped out at our Bunnings sausage sizzle on Sunday the 30<sup>th</sup> of September. The crew reported lower numbers of people than usual because of all the rain that weekend. None the less, they still were still kept busy and turned a tidy profit for the club. Again, a massive thank you to all involved!

Mick & Gina have organised another Bunnings sausage sizzle for Saturday the 24<sup>th</sup> of November. This is another great opportunity to raise funds and advertise our club to the local community. If you can lend a hand that day please speak to Mick or contact me on 0408 066 040.





